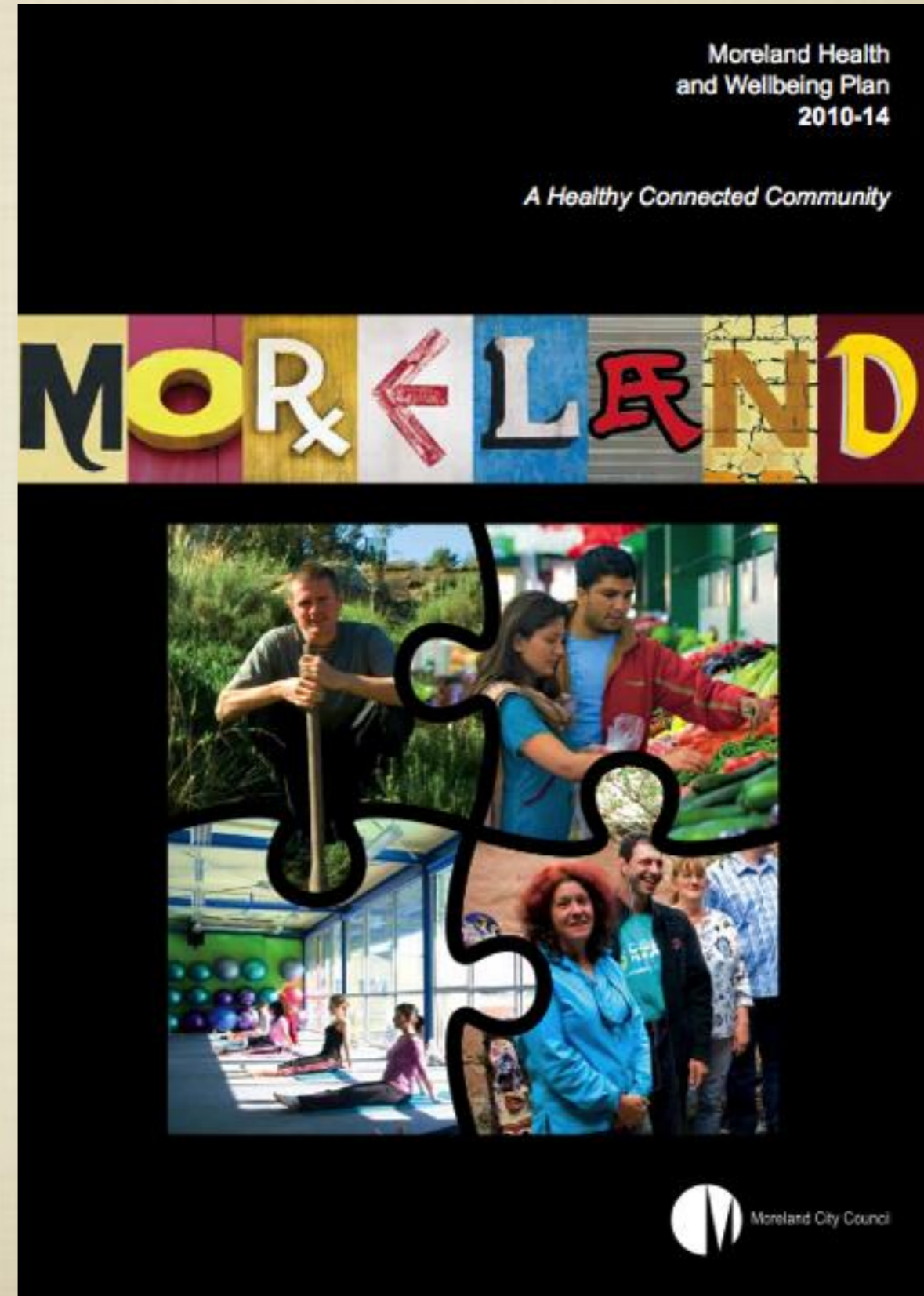

Figure 3. Projected Age Distribution Horsham Rural City Council

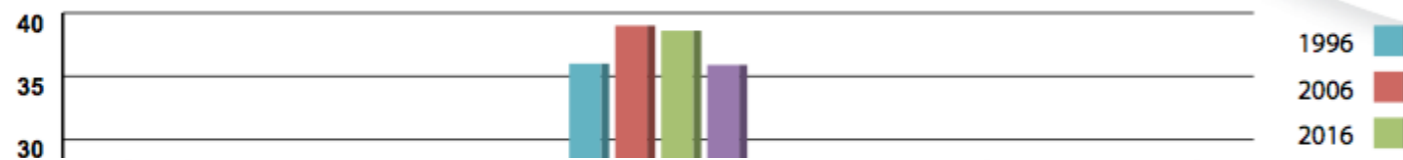
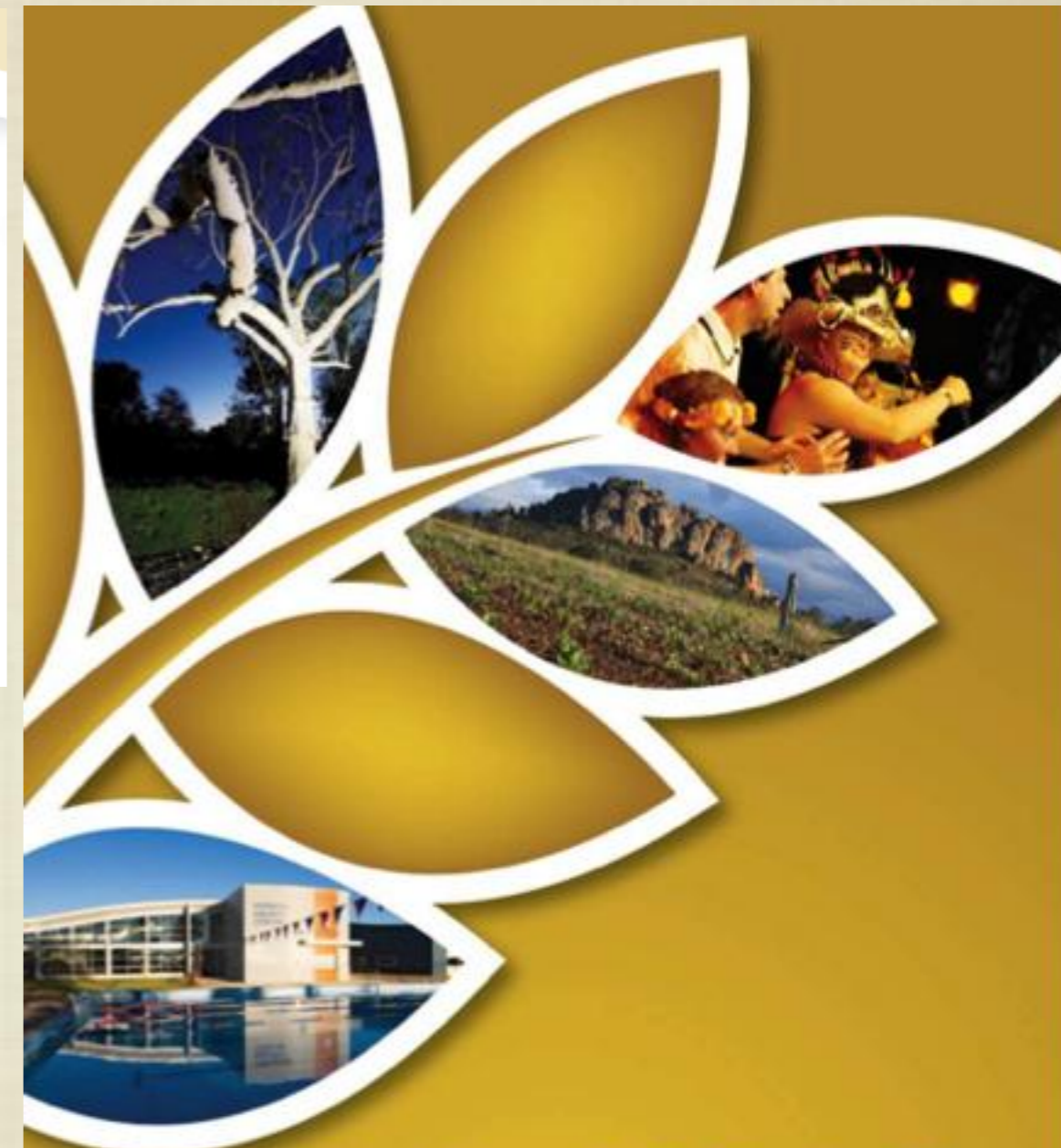

In responding to the identified health and wellbeing needs of the Darebin community, the key priorities for the Community Health and Wellbeing Plan 2009-2013 are:

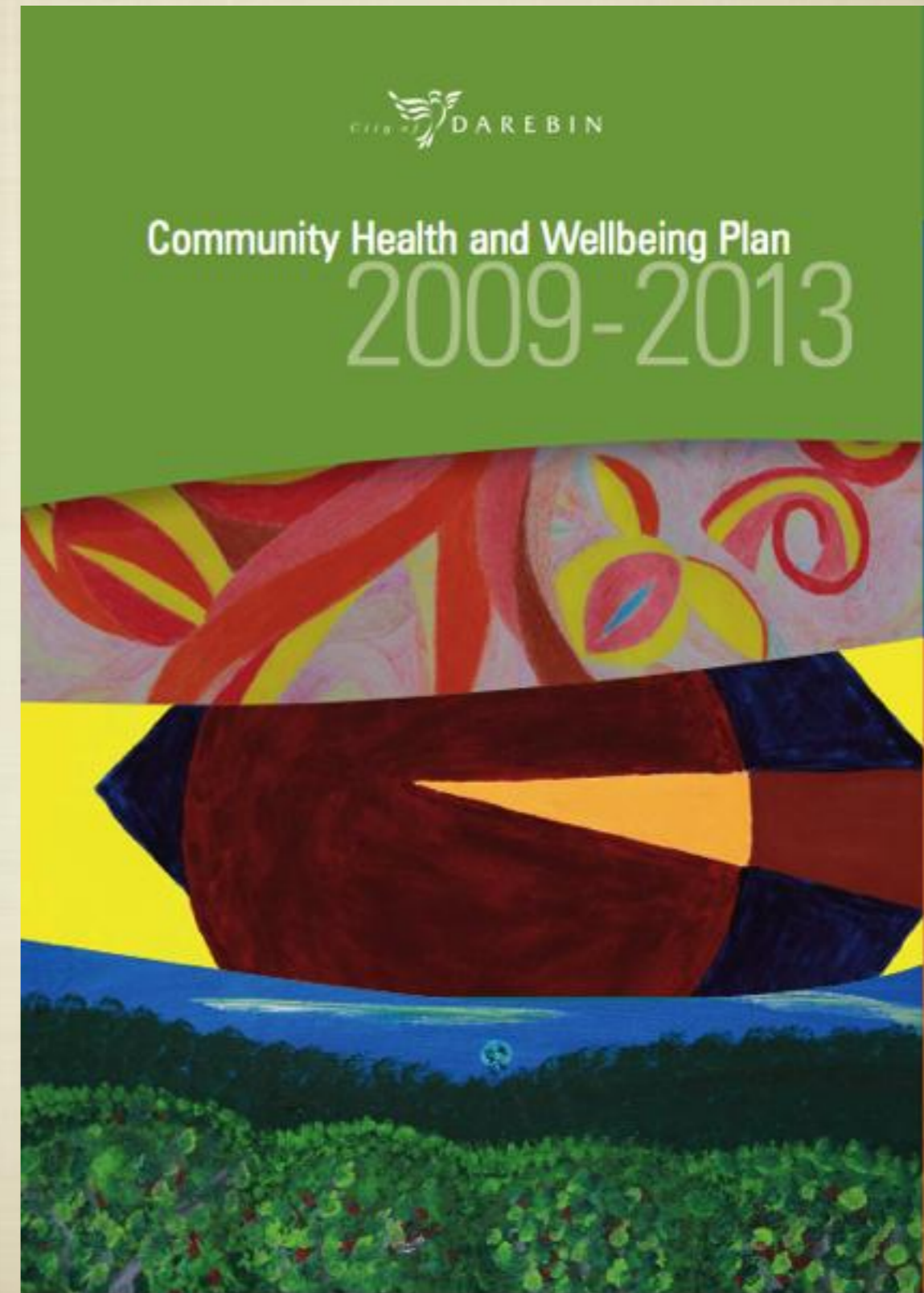

Work under these three key priority areas over 2009-2013 will contribute to meeting the overall vision for the health and wellbeing of our community.

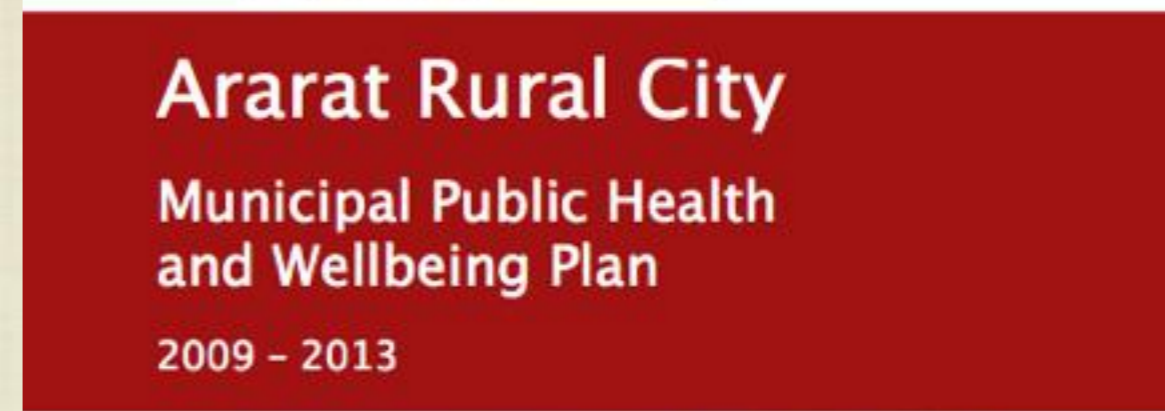
Our Vision
